### Turning the Display On

- Press the **Power** button once.

**Note: The display starts up into the built-in OS.**

### Using the built-in White Board

- Navigate to the built-in OS's homepage by pressing **Home** on the display or remote.
- Press the White board icon on the homepage and begin using the white board features.

### Using the EWS PC

- Ensure that the conference PC is powered on.
- From the built-in OS homepage, open the source selection menu (VGA Cable Icon), select the **HDMI 4** pane to allow the EWS PC to use the display.
- You may also use the **Source** buttons to select **HDMI 4** manually.

**Note: A whiteboard program is also available on the conference PC. The name of the program is **IdeaMax** and a link may be found on the desktop.**

### Using IdeaMax (Windows White Board)

### Using an HDMI Doc Cam or Laptop

- Open the front panel door and plug in the HDMI cable between the front panel (HDMI 1 port) of the display and the source device.
- If you will be using touch with a laptop, plug in a USB cable between the front panel (Touch Port 1) of the display and the laptop.
- From the built-in OS homepage, open the source selection menu (VGA Cable Icon), select the **HDMI 1** pane to allow the Doc Cam or Laptop to display.
- You may also use the **Source** buttons to select **HDMI 1** manually.

### Turning the System Off

- Press the **Power** button once.
